

MRS. JOSEPH HERZOG, WELFARE LEADER, 92

Mrs. Belle Adler Herzog, active for many years in civic, religious and welfare work, died yesterday afternoon in her home, 530 West End Avenue, in her ninety-third year. She was the widow of Joseph Herzog.

A resident of New York for more than seventy years, Mrs. Herzog was born in Van Buren, Ark. She was the daughter of the late Sarah Sulzberger and the late Samuel Adler and a sister of Dr. Cyrus Adler, Milton Adler and Celia Minzesheimer, all deceased. Her marriage to Mr. Herzog took place in Philadelphia.

Mrs. Herzog devoted much of her time as a worker in the Young Women's Hebrew Association, the Educational Alliance and in other charitable organizations. She was an organizer of the Tremont Religious School, a charter member of the After-Care of the Jewish Maternity Hospital, former vice president of the Women's League of the United Synagogue, and a member of the Shearith Israel Congregation.

She is survived by two sons, Leo S., and David S.; two daughters, Rose A., and Nina A., and a granddaughter, Sibyl H. Grubstein. Another son, Samuel A. Herzog, is deceased.

A funeral service will be held at the West End Funeral Chapel, Amsterdam Avenue and Ninety-first Street, at 10:30 A. M., tomorrow.
