(7) I have two children, and the names of the one place of birth and residence place of two sons of said children who are now citizens of the United States are: **Harry, male, born 1/7/22 at Munich, Germany; now in U.S. Army.**

(8) I have no children, and the names of the one place of birth and residence place of two daughters of said children who are now citizens of the United States are: **Lore, female, born 1/5/30 at Munich, Germany; residing Port Jervis, N.Y.**

(9) My last place of permanent residence was **Munich, Bavaria, Germany**

(10) I immigrated to the United States from **Cologne, Germany** and my last entry to permanent residence in the United States was at **New York, N.Y.** on **April 19, 1940** under the name of **Sigfried Krieger**

(11) The date of my arrival at the port of entry to the United States is **NOT** shown above from the United States, for a period or periods of 6 months or longer, as follows:

(12) I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on **July 1, 1940** in the **Fulton County, New York**. It is my intention to good faith to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce all rights and allegiance and fidelity to any and all former, present, or future, State, or sovereignty of whose or whoses ever I may be a subject or a citizen or a national. I declare that I have been for the period of at least six months prior to the date of this petition an inhabitant of the United States, and that I am a character of good repute and reputation among the neighbors of the place where I resided, and that I have not violated any provision of any regulation concerning the admission of aliens to the United States, or of the English language, or of the principles and tenets of the Constitution of the United States, or of any state or territory, or of the laws of the United States. (13) I have resided continuously in the United States for the term of 5 years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since **April 19, 1940**, and continuously in the state in which this petition is made for the term of 6 months at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since **July 1, 1940**.

(14) I declare that I have resided in the **Fulton County, New York** for a period of at least 6 months, and the cause of such continual or daily has were been cured or removed.

(15) Attached hereto and made a part of this my petition for naturalization, are my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States (of such date as may be required by the State or the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service), and my oath to renounce all rights and allegiance and to the United States for permanent residence if such certificate of naturalization be required by the Naturalization Law, and the affidavit of at least two verifying witnesses required by law.
