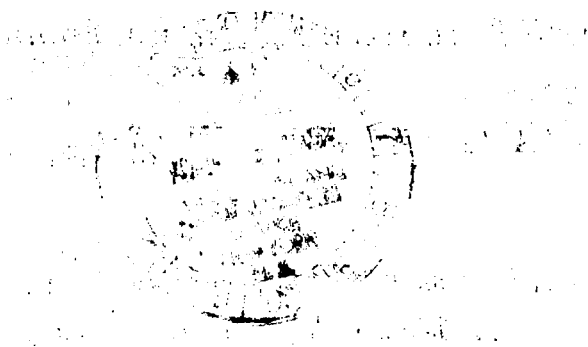

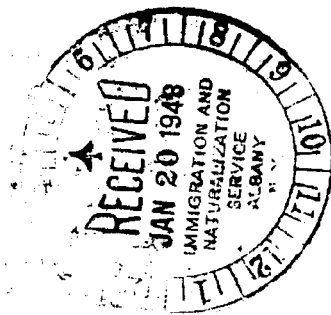
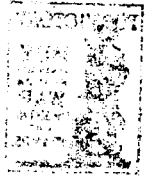

(b) An alien who married a citizen of the United States or whose spouse was naturalized on or subsequent to September 22, 1922; or
