

## ***Mrs. Adrienne H. Tinnerello Is Married to Willard H. Carr***

Willard H. Carr, a retired importer-exporter and oil executive who turned his photographic hobby into a portrait business, and Mrs. Adrienne Huyler Tinnerello of New York were married here yesterday.

The ceremony was performed in the bridegroom's Park Avenue apartment by Justice Arnold G. Fraiman of the Supreme Court. John K. Smart was the best man, and Mrs. Joseph Markart was matron of honor.

The bride attended the St. Louis Convent School in Fort Kent, Me., and her husband was graduated from the Franklin School here and from Yale. He served as a commander in the Navy during World War II.

Until 1953 the bridegroom was president of Carr Brothers,

Inc., an import-export concern founded by his father, the late Herbert J. Carr. In addition, he was an executive and director of oil producing companies, including the Amerada Corporation, which his father helped found.

Long an expert amateur photographer, Mr. Carr has in recent years operated the Edgehill Studio at 667 Madison Avenue. The studio is being renamed the Nicastro-Carr Studio and will now deal exclusively in color portraits.

Both Mr. and Mrs. Carr were previously married and divorced.

The couple plan a delayed wedding trip later in the summer to the bridegroom's country home in Washington, Conn.
