

MRS. MYRON COWEN, ENVOY'S WIDOW, 65

WASHINGTON, July 27—A funeral service for Mrs. Dorothy Frank Cowen, widow of Myron M. Cowen, a former United States Ambassador to Australia, Belgium and the Philippines, was held here today at the All Souls Unitarian Church.

Mrs. Cowen, who was 65 years old, died Tuesday of pneumonia in Casper, Wyo., where she was visiting her son, State Senator Thomas Stroock. Her home was in Washington.

She was born in New York and attended private schools in this country and in France.

Mrs. Cowen was a member of the board of the Home for Incurables in this city, a founder and board member of the Foreign Students Council and a member of the National Women's Press Club and the Women's National Democratic Club.

Surviving, in addition to her son, are a daughter, Mrs. Robert McElwaine, and five grandchildren.
