In accordance with the new alien registration regulations, my wife and I were fingerprinted in Lisbon, Portugal on March 11th, 1941 before we embarked for the United States.

On April 25, 1941 we arrived in N.Y. and a few days later I received a registration receipt card for myself only addressed to Emil Gross 331 W. 101 Street, New York --City.

Some weeks later, I discovered that though the receipt was made out for the same name Emil Gross the signature was not the mine, whereupon I immediately notified your department of a presumable mistake and returned you the receipt too.

In the meantime we moved to Los Angeles and shortly before we left New York, we received two other receipt cards for both of us in care of Mr. David Marcus 440 Jackson Ave, Bronx- N.Y. We were supposed to send them back signed and have again finger-prints taken at the Los Angeles Immigration Office.

Yet this has been denied us inasmuch as the Immigration Office would have to be authorized by your department in Washington, directly.
