S. Government.

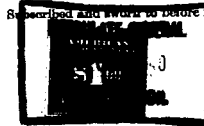



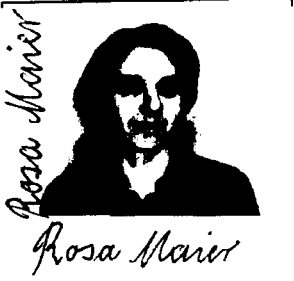
