This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act/Privacy Act (FOIA/PA) request received in this office August 4, 2006, regarding the subject: Elfriede Mical

We have completed the review of all documents responsive to your request and have identified 71 pages which are responsive to your request. Enclosed are 50 pages released in their entirety, and 21 pages released in part. We have reviewed and have determined to release all information except those portions that are exempt pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(6) and (b)(7)(C) of the FOIA.

The following exemptions are applicable:

Exemption (b)(6) permits the government to withhold all information about individuals in personnel, medical and similar files where the disclosure of such information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. The types of documents and or information withheld may consist of birth certificates, naturalization certificates, drivers license, social security numbers, home addresses, dates of birth, or various other documents and/or information belonging to a third party that are considered personal.

Exemption (b)(7)(C) provides protection for personal information in law enforcement records, which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. We have withheld various information relating to third-party individuals. The types of documents and/or information withheld could consist of names, addresses, identification numbers, telephone numbers, fax numbers, or various other documents that are considered personal.

The enclosed record consists of the best reproducible copies available.



### ALIEN ADDRESS PROGRAM

#### WHAT IT IS

The Alien Address Program is the method by which aliens are able to fulfill the requirement of the Immigration and Nationality Act of 1952. The Act requires that every alien who is in the United States on January 1, report his address during the month of January. Any alien who is temporarily absent on January 1, shall report his address within ten (10) days after his return to the United States. This law applies to all aliens even though they have not changed their addresses since the last time they submitted an address report.
